**A RESOLUTION OF THE CARPINTERIA CITY COUNCIL
COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING
WADE AND ROXANNE NOMURA
UPON BEING NAMED
CARPINTERIANS OF THE YEAR FOR 2011**

WHEREAS, each year the Carpinteria Valley Chamber of Commerce selects and honors a person as Carpinterian of the Year in recognition of contributions and volunteer service to the community; and

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2011, the Chamber announced the selection of Wade and Roxanne Nomura as Carpinterians of the Year for 2011 in recognition of their efforts and contributions to the community and enriching the lives of others; and

WHEREAS, both Wade and Roxanne Nomura, have been married for 38 years, have led their two children, Lisa and Ryan by example, exhibiting a strong and long lasting dedication to serving the community of Carpinteria for most of their married life and have individually held numerous volunteer non-profit board offices and positions, always without remuneration; and

WHEREAS, Roxanne Nomura has served as President of the Morning Rotary of Carpinteria, has been named a multiple Rotary Paul Harris Fellow, served as Director of the Carpinteria Boys & Girls Club, Director of the Junior Golf Association, Director of the local Athletic Round Table, Director of the Carpinteria Division of the American Heart Association, was active in the Carpinteria High School Stadium Campaign and donates generously to local fundraising efforts. Both husband and wife have worked full time throughout all these years of community service and continue to do so; and

WHEREAS, both Wade and Roxanne were integral to the building of the recently completed Tomol Interpretive Park on Linden Avenue in Carpinteria, working to secure a \$350,000 California State Parks grant, and helped craft a partnership with the City of Carpinteria, the Morning Rotary Club and California State Parks to finish and care for this one of a kind play area to honor Carpinteria's Native Chumash; and
